



## **What to Know To Schedule Your Appointment**

Do not schedule a vaccine right now if you have had a serious or anaphylactic reaction to any other vaccine in the past. You must talk to your doctor first.

### **Do not schedule a second dose now.**

You can schedule a first dose or booster dose now.  
However, you will schedule your second dose while at your first shot appointment.

### **Insurance information**

Complete any insurance/Medicare information. (Note: The federal government is paying for the vaccine, but insurance companies are being charged an administration fee for giving the vaccine. No one will have out-of-pocket costs.)

### **At Your Appointment**

Bring your insurance card(s) and/or Medicare card to your appointment.

Minors (under 18) who are being vaccinated must have a parent/guardian accompanying them.

If you are receiving a first dose, bring your calendar with you, as you will schedule your second vaccination while at this appointment (if receiving a 2-dose vaccine).

Plan to wait at least 15 minutes onsite after receiving your vaccine.
