



What to Know To Schedule Your Appointment

Do not schedule a vaccine right now if you have had a serious or anaphylactic reaction to any other vaccine in the past. You must talk to your doctor first.

Do not schedule your second dose now.

You will schedule your second dose while at your first shot appointment.

Insurance information

Complete any insurance/Medicare information. (Note: The federal government is paying for the vaccine, but insurance companies are being charged an administration fee for giving the vaccine. At Deaconess, this is \$38. No one will have out-of-pocket costs.)

At Your Appointment

Bring your insurance card(s) and/or Medicare card to your appointment.

Minors (ages 12-17) who are being vaccinated must have a parent/guardian accompanying them.

Bring your calendar with you, as you will schedule your second vaccination while at this appointment (if receiving a 2-dose vaccine).

Plan to wait at least 15 minutes onsite after receiving your vaccine.
