Deaconess Foundation Grants

Since March 2024, Deaconess Foundation was awarded \$119,784 from local, national, and federal grants. Funds provided by these grants support a number of the initiatives we have throughout Deaconess Health System.

The Deaconess Mobile Mammography Outreach Program received \$25,000 from the National Breast Cancer Foundation, \$24,201 from the Indiana Breast Cancer Awareness Trust, Inc., and \$10,000 from the Robinson

Foundation. Other Mammography Outreach Grants came from Perry County Community Fund for \$3,000 and Posey County Community Fund for \$2,000. The funds provide continuum of care from mammography screening to diagnosis to treatment for women in need.

Deaconess HeartSaver was awarded \$10,150 from the Gibson County Community Fund. Grant funds will be used to place 6 AEDs with organizations within Gibson County, Indiana. Through the support of

community individuals, businesses, and grants, HeartSaver has placed more than 750 AEDs in the Tri-State.

Indiana Department of Homeland Security awarded Deaconess Emergency Medical Services (EMS) \$8,176 in education funding. This grant provided books and uniforms for two Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) classes in 2024. A federal study projected a need for 40,000 more full-time emergency medical personnel from 2016 to 2030. These funds will contribute to adding 30 EMS staff to our Deaconess community.

Other notable grants received this year:

- Aldi's: \$500 for Safe Babies
- The BraveHeart Foundation: \$4,930 for Safe Babies

Deaconess Foundation graciously thanks all the organizations who provided us with grant funding supporting our programs and services.

DCARE

One of Deaconess' goals is to keep healthcare local and provide patients with the most effective and efficient healthcare. With that goal, DCARE (Deaconess Coordinating and Advancing Resources for Excellence) was launched throughout the Deaconess Health System in 2023. This centralized hospital "command center" is recognizing and removing barriers to patient care.

"Our hospitals have been very busy, and we continue to focus on making sure our patients receive the best care possible all while managing high demand" said Dr. Phillip Adams, Access Center Medical Director. Deaconess staff have witnessed firsthand the positive impact of DCARE. In the simplest terms, DCARE utilizes real time data from every facet of the Health System to streamline every patient's hospitalization.

A video wall is the integral part of the "command center" and assists the monitoring of all of the facilities within the DCARE network. Being able to coordinate patient care, track

transfers, and reduce access time for tests, procedures, and the discharging of patients is vital to improve excellent patient care and outcomes. Deaconess Foundation is appreciative of the support from the Foundation Board of Directors towards the purchase of the DCARE video wall.

SAFE BABIES

Our Safe Babies Program has provided services to expectant parents for over a year. Results have impacted the communities served by Deaconess Henderson Hospital. "Through the Safe Babies Program we are not only donating Pack 'n Plays, which is a portable baby-safe space that can be used as a travel crib, changing station, or bassinet, and infant car seats, but also supporting our patients and their families through outpatient classes and inpatient education at birth." We are extremely grateful for the gifts, tearfully knowing that without our help they would not have the means to provide safe essentials for their babies. As staff members, we realize that our Safe Babies Program is saving lives" said Laura Hish, Deaconess Maternal Child Nurse Clinician.

Deaconess Henderson Women's Hospital staff have received wonderful feedback from all mothers and their families regarding the classes with the Safe Babies Program. Every week participants are provided with much needed items and education to aid in the safety of their infants. Partnering with Marsha's Place, a pregnancy resource center in Henderson, the Safe Babies Program has seen positive outcomes and will continue spreading awareness within the community.


