Program Information

- » Registered Nurse is a registered apprenticeship program with the Department of Labor.
- » Available to Ivy Tech students enrolled in the ASN program.
- » Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) as a Registered Nurse (RN)
 - Coursework and clinicals completed at Ivy Tech and a Deaconess hospital inpatient unit.
 - Students are eligible for tuition reimbursement.
- » Student apprentices are employed in a Deaconess hospital in a full-time position.
 - Apply for employment at www.deaconess.com/ careers
- » Student apprentice schedule:
 - Ivy Tech coursework and clinicals 3-4 days per week.
 - Work at a Deaconess site for up to 20 hours a week
 - This apprenticeship position will conclude upon successful completion of all coursework, clinical hours, graduation with an Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) degree, and acceptance of a graduate nurse role.
