DONOR SPOTLIGHT

Shane and Amy Clements have long been dedicated advocates for Deaconess and the Deaconess Foundation, offering their time, leadership, and generosity to improve the lives of patients and families throughout the region.

Originally from Evansville, Shane met Amy, a Chicago-area native, while attending Indiana University Bloomington. After beginning their life together in Carmel, Indiana, they made the decision to return to Shane's hometown, where he assumed leadership of the family's construction and land development business. Shane has since made a lasting impact on the local business community, serving as President of the Southwestern Indiana Builders Association and sitting on its board for over a decade.

Amy, a passionate community volunteer, has devoted much of her time in Evansville to philanthropic service. She is a past President of the Junior League of Evansville, where she served for 10 years, and has contributed her leadership to several nonprofit boards including the Easterseals Rehabilitation Center, Ark Crisis Child Care Center, and the CMOE Children's Museum. Her dedication to chairing events and supporting causes that directly benefit those most in need speaks to her unwavering commitment to the Evansville community.

The Clements' support of Deaconess is deeply personal, particularly in the area of oncology. Motivated by a strong connection to those affected by cancer, they are actively

involved in enhancing the patient and family experience. Through their work with the Deaconess Patient Family Advisory Council, Shane and Amy are helping identify ways the health system can improve comfort, communication, and care for those facing difficult diagnoses.

"As far as a large hospital system goes, I understand the questions people might have," she shared. "But being able to volunteer and see the 'why' behind how Deaconess and the Foundation operate has been an incredibly rewarding experience."

When asked what advice she would give to others considering support for the Foundation, Amy shared, "The Foundation's support is evident not only in the Health System, but throughout the community. The funding helps in ways far beyond what most people realize. It's essential in getting patients to life-saving chemotherapy, nurse's education, the availability of AED's where

needed, and many more essential services benefiting patients, their families, and the Deaconess family. Everything the foundation does is rooted in supporting the community."

She and Shane summarized their purpose simply and powerfully: "We support the Foundation because the Foundation supports those who need it most."

On May 12, 2025, Deaconess Foundation proudly hosted the annual Deaconess Classic for Women's Health, a signature golf event dedicated to increasing awareness around women's health and the life-saving importance of early detection.

Held at the beautiful Evansville Country Club, the 2025 Classic brought together more than 180 women for a fun-filled day of golf, camaraderie, and purpose. With a record number of hole sponsors, engaging on-course games, and generous community support, this year's event raised **\$144,800** in funds to provide mammograms and pelvic ultrasounds for underinsured and uninsured women throughout the Tri-State area.

Since its inception in 1995, the Deaconess Classic has raised over **\$4 million** dollars and helped deliver more than **15,000** free mammogram screenings to women throughout the tri-state area. These life changing screenings and care are all made possible by the generosity of our sponsors, participants, and donors.

GIFTS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

NICVIEW® Cameras: Keeping Families Connected When It Matters Most

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, Deaconess Foundation has helped bring a powerful new source of comfort and connection to families with newborns in the Deaconess Henderson Hospital Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in Henderson, Kentucky.

For many families, the joy of welcoming a new baby can be met with unexpected challenges, especially when that baby requires specialized care in the NICU. Whether due to distance, work obligations, or active military duty, not every loved one can be physically present during those first critical days, weeks, or even months. That absence can weigh heavily on parents, siblings, and extended family members who long to bond with their newest family member.

With donor support, six NICVIEW® 2 cameras were recently installed at Deaconess Henderson Hospital. These secure, real-time video streaming devices provide 24/7 access for families to see their babies, no matter where they are in the world. The cameras offer reassurance, connection, and a sense of involvement in their child's early care journey, transforming moments of fear into moments of love, hope, and healing.

This technology doesn't just stream video; it helps ensure that every baby in the NICU stays connected with their family from the start.

Investing in Our Future: Scholarships That Strengthen Our Workforce

At Deaconess, education isn't just a goal—it's a pathway to better care. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, the Deaconess Foundation continues to provide critical scholarship support for doctors, nurses, and staff pursuing advanced education in their fields.

Between October 2024 and August 2025, Deaconess Foundation awarded \$346,500 in scholarships to team members across departments such as Nursing, Imaging/CT, Diagnostic Radiology, Human Resources, Pharmacy, and Clinic Administration. our staff can grow professionally while continuing to provide outstanding care.

NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS

Investing in the Future of Care: Deaconess Nursing Scholarships

Inspiring the Next Generation: 32 Years of the Health Science Institute

For more than three decades, Deaconess has proudly opened its doors to local high school students through the Deaconess/Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation (EVSC) Health Science Institute. The Health Science Institute is a two-week immersive program designed to introduce young minds to the world of healthcare.

From June 1-14, 2025, 27 students from area high schools participated in this year's program, gaining hands-on experience across various departments within Deaconess Health System. With support from Deaconess Foundation, and in partnership with EVSC, these students explored careers in nursing, radiology, surgery, pharmacy, and more. Students are guided by experienced healthcare professionals who generously shared their time and expertise to the Health Science Institute.

Students also had the opportunity to expand their learning beyond Deaconess Hospital's walls with visits to Purdue University, Marian University, University of Evansville and the University of Southern Indiana, where they explored academic pathways in health sciences and connected their real-world experience to future possibilities.

Now in its 32nd year, the Health Science Institute continues to be a powerful launching pad for students considering a future in healthcare. Many past participants have gone on to pursue careers at Deaconess, some returning as doctors, nurses, and team members who once stood in the very same hallways as aspiring students. Thanks to donor support, this program doesn't just educate, it inspires, equips, and empowers the healthcare leaders of tomorrow.
