DEACONESS CLASSIC CELEBRATES 30 YEARS

A day for women, supporting women, and organized by women all began with a passion for a cause. On May 13, 2024, the Deaconess Classic celebrated its 30th anniversary with a memorable 'Putts, Pars, and Pearls' Golf Classic. Over the past 30 years, this golf event for women has been a beacon of hope, providing over 15,000 mammograms and pelvic ultrasounds to underinsured or uninsured women in the Deaconess Community. This is a testament to the collective commitment to women's healthcare.

More than 30 years ago, a group of community women had a vision to create a golf event for women to support breast cancer awareness and treatment. When the first Classic was held in 1995, many doubted its success. They were told that an all-women's event would not attract enough golfers. But these women, fueled by their passion and determination, proved the critics wrong. The Deaconess Classic

has been a sell-out for the past 30 years, raising over a total of \$4 million for women in our community.

A volunteer committee working with the Deaconess Foundation staff brings the event to life. "I love that women come year after year to help other women in our community. The Deaconess committee works very hard to ensure every detail makes the event successful," Lisa Loehrlein, 2024 Classic Committee Chair, said. "We have helped so many women get necessary breast screenings and pelvic exams. Having breast cancer myself, I know the importance of helping other women receive the medical care they need."

With her family present, the late Holley Brundick was honored at this year's dinner. The Pearls of Wisdom Award was given to Holly's family for her commitment to raising funds. Holley served as the first



Deaconess Classic committee chair and passionately served our community.

The Pam Rausch Spirit Award is named annually in Pam's memory and awarded to a community member who goes above and beyond to support cancer survivors. This year's award was presented to Lori Barron. Lori is a retired Deaconess Cardiac Nurse. After retirement, she wanted to still give back to the community. Her heart led her to Chemo Buddies. A recent cancer patient spoke about Lori and said, "There was always something about the smile on her face that made you feel like everything was going to be all right. She genuinely interacted with my husband and me. She was never far away with some item of comfort and even followed up with me for months after my chemo was finished. Lori is more than a chemo buddy. She is the warmth when you walk into the room, the caring smile for an uneasy spirit. She has become a lifelong friend."

Our volunteers, committee members and golfers are not just participants in an

event; they are the heart and soul of the Deaconess Classic. Their commitment and enthusiasm ensure the continuation of this life-saving event for years to come. Health Science Institute

For 34 years, Deaconess has opened its doors to future health care providers... local high school students. Through a two-week program in partnership with Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation and funded by Deaconess Foundation, students gain firsthand experience in various medical careers, helping them make informed decisions about their future. Students earn one semester of high school credit in Advanced Applied Science for satisfactorily completing the Institute.

In a year between 25 and 30 students are accepted into the Health Science Institute (HSI) from more than 100 applicants representing 13 area high schools.

Each year through HSI, students have operated a daVinci surgical robot,

attended 12 clinical observations in various clinical areas, and heard from 20+ physicians and nearly 75 total speakers in healthcare who shared their career details with students.

“I was an HSI student when I was in high school, and it confirmed my desire to become a physician. I referred back to those experiences throughout my medical training. I am now an Anesthesiologist at Deaconess Hospital! HSI is a fantastic opportunity that is made for budding health care professionals” Dr. Cameron Waller, MD, said.

As part of the HIS program, students had the opportunity to visit Deaconess campuses, the University of Evansville, the University of Southern Indiana, Ivy Tech Community College Evansville, Purdue University and Marian University. At Deaconess,



they shadowed Deaconess healthcare professionals and gained insight into the medical field, all while residing at the Midtown campus.

HSI seeks to provide an opportunity for students to explore healthcare in-depth. 75-80% of students who attend HSI continue on to have a career in the medical field. Many HSI students have commented that it is “a life-changing experience.” The expected outcome of HSI is to promote medical careers, allow students to see the benefits and rewards of pursuing a career in medicine, and broaden their knowledge through interaction with leading health care professionals.

Much credit for the HSI program goes to Rachel Heck, Coordinator of Deaconess/EVSC Health Science Institute. She said, “A student came

back from a clinical observation period in tears. I asked her what happened, and she said she saw the most amazing nurse take her entire lunch break to sit with a hospice patient who had no one. The student said this nurse does it every day and takes time after her shift to just be with the patient. The student said, ‘No one talks about that side of healthcare, but that is the important side.’”

Cardiac Scales

The Deaconess Foundation's funding of patient scales for every room on the Cardiac Renal units at Midtown and Gateway has improved patient care for cardiac patients. Staff can quickly weigh the patient when the scale is already in the room.

With the new scales, providers can more accurately treat patients and the staff can educate patients on the importance of daily weights. This not only sets a good example for patients but also ensures they are well-prepared to prevent readmission when they leave the hospital.

"The Foundation has greatly supported our heart failure team. Through their contributions, we placed a standing scale in every patient room on four cardiac units at Midtown and Gateway," Brittany Wannemuehler, Cardiac Heart Failure Manager, said. "We were also able to purchase additional scales for our heart failure patients who cannot afford one. With this, they can weigh themselves daily, as recommended. This funding has been a benefit to both staff and our Deaconess team. Thank you!"

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Training Equipment

According to the American Heart Association, outside of the hospital, cardiac arrests most often occur in homes/residences (73.4%), followed by public settings (16.3%) and nursing homes (10.3%). These statistics underscore the importance of immediate CPR, which can double or triple the chance of survival from an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest
