# The Reality

## The incidence of cancer is on the rise.

Cancer diagnoses are increasing across the country. While part of that growth reflects an aging population, a troubling rise in cancer among younger adults is also emerging.

As these trends continue, Deaconess anticipates its cancer patient volume will grow by more than 50% in the coming years. Expanded access to care in Illinois,

where Deaconess has launched a new oncology program, is also contributing to this rapid increase.

More families are turning to Deaconess for cancer care than ever before. Meeting this growing demand requires thoughtful investment in space, technology and coordinated services, so every patient receives timely, advanced care close to home.

**Nearly 4 in 10 men and women will be diagnosed with cancer during their lifetime.**

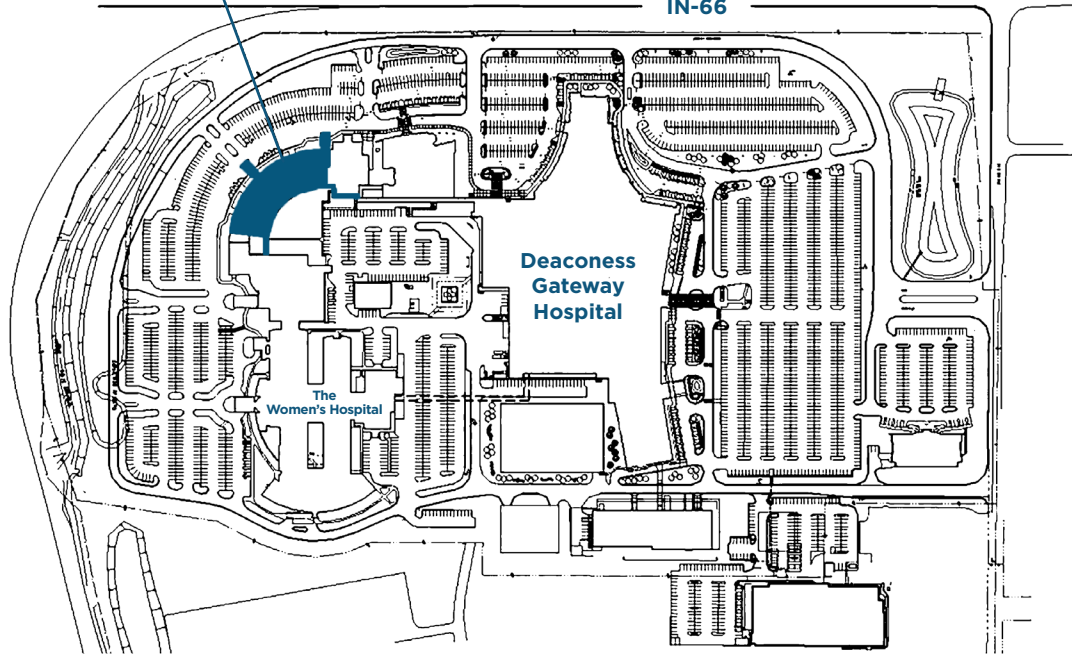
- In 2023 alone, 10,425 people in the Indiana, Illinois and Kentucky communities served by Deaconess were newly diagnosed with cancer.

# Community Room

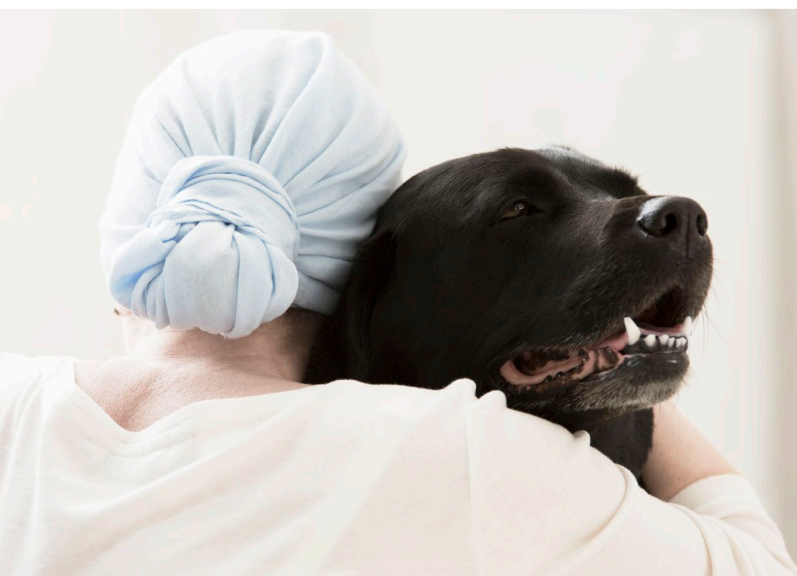
The community room, located on the first floor, is a welcoming, flexible space designed to bring patients, family members and caregivers together in comfort and connection.
